Subject: Bill Brief on House Bill 2101

House Bill 2101 prohibits municipalities from implementing a guaranteed income program.

HB 2101 would adopt a new section of law prohibiting a city or county from adopting an ordinance or resolution that establishes or provides for the operation of a guaranteed income program. Any ordinance or resolution currently in effect prior to the effective date of this bill would be null and void.

Subsection (c) defines "guaranteed income program" as a program that provides individuals with a regular periodic cash payment that may be used for any purpose without requiring such individuals to be employed, seek employment or attend employment related training to receive such funds.

The bill would go into effect on publication in the statute book, July 1, 2025.
