Subject: Bill Brief on House Bill 2240

House Bill 2240 requires legislative approval of any medicaid state plan, state plan amendment, demonstration or waiver that expands coverage or increases cost to the state.

This bill enacts a new section of law that would prohibit state agencies from seeking or implementing a medicaid state plan, state plan amendment, state demonstration or waiver pursuant to section 1115 or 1915 of the federal social security act that would expand coverage to additional classes of individuals or increase costs to the state unless the legislature has expressly consented to such action. The provisions of this section would not apply to any state plan amendment or wavier already being implemented prior to the effective date of this legislation.

This bill would go into effect upon publication in the Kansas statute book, July 1, 2025.
