Dear Mr. Chairman and Committee members,

I would like to share my Proponent testimony for SB 5. I have become aware that during the Biden administration we began to see how it could be possible for unapproved federal funds could affect our local elections. I would like to thank Opportunity Solutions for being diligent with their research and knowledge of the issues they have been bringing to the attention of our Kansas legislators.

Depending on who oversees the administration of the United States, rules, procedures, and agendas can vary greatly. Glenn Beck and his media outlet BlazeTV produced an hour-long segment in which he highlighted an NGO named DEMOS and the back door implementation of NGOs into national elections.
