Chair Thompson and Members of the Committee. I am both an educator, having taught at UMKC for almost three decades and the head of an organization that has twenty-five years investigated the roots of migration in Mexico and Central America. With that knowledge and with compassion for your youth challenged by the rising cost of higher education, I urge you to vote against SB254.

I urge you to go out a meet some of our young people with DACA or those too young to have benefitted from DACA since applications were terminated several years ago.
