Chairman Warren and Members of the Committee, thank you for letting me share my thoughts on HB 2062. My name is Austin Vawter and I am a voter in Wichita. I am writing to encourage the committee to vote NO on HB 2062.

This bill is clearly aimed to circumvent the will of the Kansas people who overwhelmingly voted in favor of the right to an abortion in 2022 via the direct ballot measure.
