MEMORANDUM

Subject: Senate Bill No. 18 (As Introduced)

Summary

Senate Bill No. 18 provides for a new distinctive license plate – the Hunter Nation distinctive license plate. Initial registrations and subsequent renewals would be made through the county treasurer. The payment of up to \$5,000 in development costs as such requirements are set forth in K.S.A. 8-1,141 would be required prior to the production of the plate. An annual logo use royalty payment fee in the amount of \$25 up to \$100, to be determined by Hunter Nation, Inc., would be required for the plates and such fees would go to the Hunter Nation, Inc.

Section 2 of the bill decreases the requirements for when the Division of Vehicles would proceed with manufacturing and distributing distinctive license plates. The initial plate and reoccurring bi-annual renewal commitment would be decreased from 250 to 100 plates.
