Subject: Senate Bill No. 98 (As Introduced)

Summary

Senate Bill No. 98 provides for a new distinctive license plate – the Route 66 Association of Kansas license plate. The plate would be subject to the 250 initial plate commitment and payment of up to \$5,000 in development costs as such requirements are set forth in K.S.A. 8-1,141. Initial registrations and subsequent renewals would be made through the county treasurer. An annual logo use royalty payment fee in the amount of \$25 up to \$100, to be determined by the Route 66 Association of Kansas, would be required for the plates and such fees would go to the Route 66 Association of Kansas.
