MEMORANDUM

Subject: House Bill No. 2031 (As Amended by House Committee)

Summary

House Bill No. 2031 permits driving school instructors and motorcycle driving school instructors to possess a driver's license from any state.

K.S.A. 8-276 provides the requirements for a person to qualify as a driving school instructor. Currently, one of the requirements for a driving school instructor is that the person must hold a valid Kansas drivers' license.

House Bill No. 2031 permits driving and instructors to possess a driver's licenses from another state and will no longer require that the license be issued by the State of Kansas. Additionally, motorcycle driving instructors would be allowed to possess a valid class M driver's license or an equivalent license from another state as long as the instructor met the other qualifications for all driving school instructors.
