

REPORTS OF STANDING COMMITTEES

MR. PRESIDENT:

The Committee on **Federal and State Affairs** recommends **HB 2437**, As Amended by House Committee, be amended on page 1, in line 11, by striking "this act" and inserting "sections 1 through 6, and amendments thereto";

On page 2, in line 5, by striking "and senate committees" and inserting "committee"; also in line 5, after "elections" by inserting "and the senate committee on federal and state affairs"; in line 10, after "(c)" by inserting "the number of voters identified as potential deceased;

(d)";

Also on page 2, in line 11, by striking "as a result of" and inserting "first identified in";

And by redesignating subsections, paragraphs, subparagraphs and clauses accordingly;

Also on page 2, in line 22, by striking "the"; also in line 22, by striking "system";

On page 3, in line 24, after "(e)" by inserting "The secretary of state shall notify the appropriate county election officer to send a confirmation notice, upon which a registrant may state such registrant's current address, within 45 days of any of the following events:

(1) The change of address information supplied by the national change of address program identifies a registrant whose address may have changed; or

(2) it appears from information provided by the director of the division of vehicles that a registrant has moved to a different residence address outside of the county in which the registrant is currently registered.

Also on page 3, in line 29, by striking all after "(2)"; by striking all in line 30; in line 31, by

striking "(3)"; in line 34, by striking "(4)" and inserting "(3)"; by striking all in lines 37 through 39; in line 40, by striking "registered";

On page 4, in line 8, by striking "(f)" and inserting "(g)";

On page 5, in line 27, after the semicolon by inserting "and"; in line 28, by striking all after "(B)"; by striking all in line 29; in line 30, by striking "(C)";

And by redesignating subsections, paragraphs, subparagraphs and clauses accordingly;

Also on page 5, in line 40, by striking "motor"; in line 43, after the comma by inserting "all available";

On page 6, in line 10, by striking "motor"; in line 13, after the comma by inserting "all available"; in line 16, after "investigation" by inserting "that indicates that the voter may no longer intend to be a registered voter in Kansas"; in line 17, after "to" by inserting "send a confirmation notice to both the registrant's address on the voter registration rolls and to the current address on the new driver's license, upon which a registrant may state such registrant's permanent address. Within 45 days after sending the confirmation notice, if the registrant does not respond or confirms their intent to no longer be registered to vote in Kansas, the county election officer shall"; also in line 17, by striking "any"; in line 18, by striking all before "such"; and the bill be passed as amended.
