

REPORTS OF STANDING COMMITTEES

MR. SPEAKER:

The Committee on **Child Welfare and Foster Care** recommends **HB 2639** be amended on page 1, by striking all in lines 13 through 35;

By striking all on pages 2 through 7;

On page 8, by striking all in lines 1 through 30.

On page 14, in line 6, by striking all after the stricken material; in line 7, by striking "stabilization" and inserting "experiencing a behavioral health crisis";

On page 16, by striking all in lines 5 through 43;

By striking all on pages 17 through 19;

On page 20, by striking all in line 1;

On page 21, in line 12, by striking "in need of stabilization" and inserting "experiencing a behavioral health crisis";

On page 22, in line 40, before the period by inserting "who is experiencing a behavioral health crisis";

On page 23, in line 4, by striking "building skills" and inserting "skill building"; also in line 4, by striking all after "family"; in line 5, by striking all before "and" and inserting "and individual communication skill building"; in line 14, by striking the second "and"; in line 16, after "exits" by inserting "; and

(6) allow access to faith-based services";

On page 24, in line 3, by striking all before "within" and inserting "not more than 90 days";

On page 25, in line 42, by striking all after "(h)"; by striking all in line 43;

On page 26, by striking all in lines 1 through 8; in line 9, by striking "(i)"; in line 14, before ""Cross-over"" by inserting ""Behavioral health crisis" means behavioral and conduct issues that impact the safety or health of a juvenile, members of the juvenile's household or family or members of the community, including, but not limited to, non-life threatening mental health and substance abuse concerns.

Also on page 26, also in line 14, by striking all after "means"; by striking all in lines 15 and 16; in line 17, by striking all before the semicolon and inserting "a young person 10 years of age or older who is at risk of being adjudicated as a child in need of care due in whole or in part to conduct or involvement in the juvenile justice system or allegations that could result in involvement in the juvenile justice system";

And by redesignating subsections, paragraphs, subparagraphs and clauses accordingly;

On page 27, by striking all in lines 3 through 43;

On page 28, by striking all in lines 1 through 16; in line 25, by striking "in need of"; in line 26, by striking "stabilization" and inserting "experiencing behavioral health crisis";

On page 29, in line 43, by striking "\$2,000,000" and inserting "\$4,000,000";

On page 33, in line 4, by striking all after "(B)"; by striking all in lines 5 through 11; in line 12, by striking all before the period and inserting "Upon request of a parent, guardian, custodian or juvenile intake and assessment worker, law enforcement may assist with the safe transportation of a juvenile to an appropriate placement, including a juvenile stabilization center, when such assistance is necessary to ensure the safety of the juvenile or others. Such assistance

shall not be construed as an arrest, detention or criminal custody";

Also on page 33, in line 36, by striking "38-2202, 38-2231,"; also in line 36, by striking "38-2302,"; also in line 36, by striking ", 72-6287";

And by renumbering sections accordingly;

On page 1, in the title, in line 9, by striking "38-2202, 38-2231,"; also in line 9, by striking "38-2302,"; also in line 9, by striking ", 72-6287"; and the bill be passed as amended.
