MR. CHAIRMAN:

I move to amend **HB 2453**, As Amended by House Committee, on page 14, following line 10, by inserting:

"Sec. 9. K.S.A. 35-107 is hereby amended to read as follows: 35-107. (a) ~~On and after January 1, 2006,~~ The following days are declared to be legal public holidays and are to be observed as such:

New Year's Day, January 1;

Martin Luther King, Jr. Day, the third Monday in January;

President's Day, the third Monday in February;

Memorial Day, the last Monday in May;

Independence Day, July 4;

Labor Day, the first Monday in September;

Columbus Day, the second Monday in October;

Veterans' Day, the eleventh day in November;

Election Day, the Tuesday following the first Monday in even-numbered years;

Thanksgiving Day, the fourth Thursday in November;

Christmas Day, December 25.

(b) Any reference in the laws of this state concerning observance of legal holidays shall ~~on and after January 1, 2006,~~ be considered as a reference to the day or days prescribed in subsection (a) for the observance of such legal holiday or holidays.";

Also on page 14, in line 11, by striking the first "and" and inserting a comma; also in line

11, after "25-1136" by inserting "and 35-107";

And by renumbering sections accordingly;

On page 1, in the title, in line 6, after the semicolon by inserting "declaring the even-numbered year general election day as a legal public holiday;"; in line 7, by striking the first "and" and inserting a comma; also in line 7, after "25-1136" by inserting "and 35-107"
