
SUBJECT: Fiscal Note for HB 2046 by House Committee on Insurance

In accordance with KSA 75-3715a, the following fiscal note concerning HB 2046 is respectfully submitted to your committee.

Currently, travel insurance is classified and filed under an inland marine line of insurance. HB 2046 would allow travel insurance that provides coverage for sickness, accident, disability, or death occurring during travel either exclusively, or in conjunction with related coverages of emergency evacuation or repatriation of remains, to be classified and filed under either an accident and health or an inland marine line of insurance.

The Kansas Department of Insurance states that the bill would not have a fiscal effect.
