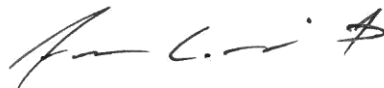
SUBJECT: Fiscal Note for HB 2100 by Representative Woodard

In accordance with KSA 75-3715a, the following fiscal note concerning HB 2100 is respectfully submitted to your committee.

HB 2100 would authorize a pharmacist to screen and initiate prophylactic therapy for a patient for post-exposure to HIV pursuant to a statewide protocol adopted by the Board of Pharmacy.

The Board of Pharmacy indicates with enactment of HB 2100, the Board would be responsible for research, legal review, and drafting the protocol for prophylactic therapy. In addition, Board inspectors would be responsible for responding to practice questions, conducting inspections to review proper implementation and use of the protocol, and investigations on all complaints. There would likely be costs to the Board in the form of staff time and resources necessary to carry out the duties. These costs would be absorbed within existing resources.
