
**SUBJECT:** Fiscal Note for HB 2135 by House Committee on Agriculture and Natural Resources

In accordance with KSA 75-3715a, the following fiscal note concerning HB 2135 is respectfully submitted to your committee.

HB 2135 would amend current law by making certain provisions of the Commercial Industrial Hemp Act applicable only if the Kansas Department of Agriculture has submitted a state plan to the federal government for state monitoring and regulation of industrial hemp within Kansas and such state plan is still active.

The Kansas Department of Agriculture and the Office of the State Fire Marshal indicate that enactment of the bill would have no fiscal effect on their operations.
