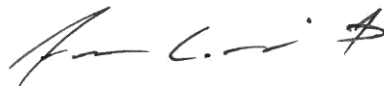
SUBJECT: Fiscal Note for HB 2145 by House Committee on Local Government

In accordance with KSA 75-3715a, the following fiscal note concerning HB 2145 is respectfully submitted to your committee.

HB 2145 would establish the Butler County Fair Board, which would consist of 15 members. An annual meeting for the appointment of members to the Board to succeed members with expiring terms would be conducted each December by the presiding county commissioners. At the annual meeting, one Board member would be appointed, if possible, from each county commissioner district and not more than five members may be appointed from the county at large. Any person residing in the county and who is of legal voting age would be eligible for membership on the Board.

The Kansas Association of Counties states enactment of the bill could have a fiscal effect on Butler County; however, the Association does not have enough information to estimate what that fiscal effect would be. The Association also states there would be no fiscal effect to any other Kansas county.
