
**SUBJECT:** Fiscal Note for HB 2166 by House Committee on Judiciary

In accordance with KSA 75-3715a, the following fiscal note concerning HB 2166 is respectfully submitted to your committee.

HB 2166 would remove sunset provisions for confidentiality of certain records making certain records that have been reviewed in the 2024 and 2025 Legislative Sessions, as certified by the Revisor of Statutes, exceptions to the Kansas Open Records Act. The bill would also remove the requirement for legislative review of those exceptions.

The Division of the Budget has requested fiscal information from the Office of Revisor of Statutes and Legislative Administrative Services and is awaiting responses. However, the Division estimates that the bill would not have a fiscal effect. The fiscal note will be updated if either agency reports an estimated fiscal effect.
