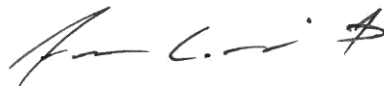
**SUBJECT:** Fiscal Note for HB 2170 by House Committee on Health and Human Services

In accordance with KSA 75-3715a, the following fiscal note concerning HB 2170 is respectfully submitted to your committee.

HB 2170 would designate the first full week of February as Kansas Burn Awareness Week. The purpose of the week would be to commemorate those who have lost their lives or been injured due to burns, raise awareness of the seriousness of accidental burn injuries and fatalities, and educate the public on effective preventative measures to avoid such injuries or fatalities. The bill would take effect on July 1, 2025.

The State Fire Marshal indicates that enactment of the bill would have no fiscal effect on its operations.
