
**SUBJECT:** Fiscal Note for HB 2182 by House Committee on Judiciary

In accordance with KSA 75-3715a, the following fiscal note concerning HB 2182 is respectfully submitted to your committee.

HB 2182 would prohibit a sheriff from charging a fee for the service of process in proceedings under the Protection from Abuse Act and the Protection from Stalking, Sexual Assault, or Human Trafficking Act. The bill would take effect on July 1, 2025.

The Judiciary indicates that enactment of the bill would have no fiscal effect on state revenues or expenditures; however, the agency notes that the bill has the potential to decrease county government revenues by unknown amounts. The Kansas Association of Counties indicates that the bill would decrease county government revenues; however, a precise estimate of this effect could not be provided.
