SUBJECT: Fiscal Note for HB 2225 by House Committee on Energy, Utilities and Telecommunications


In accordance with KSA 75-3715a, the following fiscal note concerning HB 2225 is respectfully submitted to your committee.

HB 2225 would amend current law to prohibit mobile home park landlords from limiting a tenant's access to communications and video services.

The Kansas Corporation Commission, Citizens' Utility Ratepayer Board, Office of the Attorney General, and Office of Judicial Administration indicate that the enactment of the bill would not have a fiscal effect on their operations.
