SUBJECT: Fiscal Note for HB 2227 by House Committee on Corrections and Juvenile Justice

In accordance with KSA 75-3715a, the following fiscal note concerning HB 2227 is respectfully submitted to your committee.

HB 2227 would prohibit the use of prone restraint on a juvenile who is in custody at a juvenile correctional or detention facility or being assessed as part of the juvenile intake assessment system. The bill would define prone restraint as the use of manual restraint that places the person in a face-down position.

The Judiciary and the Department of Corrections indicate that enactment of the bill would have no fiscal effect on agency operations. The Kansas Association of Counties indicates that the bill would have an unknown fiscal effect on counties.
