
**SUBJECT:** Fiscal Note for HB 2285 by House Committee on Health and Human Services

In accordance with KSA 75-3715a, the following fiscal note concerning HB 2285 is respectfully submitted to your committee.

HB 2285 would amend the Residential Childhood Lead Poisoning Prevention Act to update the definition of “lead based paint” to mean paint or other surface coatings that contain lead equal to or in excess of 0.009 percent by weight or in excess of the amount specified in federal law, whichever is less.

According to the Kansas Department of Health and Environment, enactment of HB 2285 would not result in a fiscal effect for the agency.
