
SUBJECT: Fiscal Note for HB 2313 by House Committee on Financial Institutions and Pensions

In accordance with KSA 75-3715a, the following fiscal note concerning HB 2313 is respectfully submitted to your committee.

HB 2313 would prohibit state agencies from using any electronic device that is owned or issued to an employee to access an artificial intelligence platform of concern. The bill would define “artificial intelligence platform of concern” to mean the artificial intelligence model known as DeepSeek or an artificial intelligence model that is controlled by a country of concern. Any agencies that utilize an artificial intelligence platform would be required to delete accounts and no longer use the platform. The provisions of the bill would not apply to state agencies using such platforms for law enforcement purposes or cybersecurity investigations.

The Office of Information Technology Services indicates enactment of the bill would not have a fiscal effect on the agency. The Office notes that it is not aware of any state agencies using the technology described in the bill.
