
SUBJECT: Fiscal Note for HB 2316 by House Committee on Health and Human Services

In accordance with KSA 75-3715a, the following fiscal note concerning HB 2316 is respectfully submitted to your committee.

HB 2316 would establish two new funds, the Disability Community Services Providers Civil Monetary Penalty Reinvestment Fund and the Adult Care Homes Civil Monetary Penalty Reinvestment Fund. Civil penalties collected for violations of correction orders by the State Fire Marshal would be deposited into these funds, and the funds would be used exclusively for grants awarded to current licensees for projects that benefit the health, safety, and welfare of individuals served by adult care homes or disability services providers.

The Department for Aging and Disability Services and the State Fire Marshal indicate that enactment of the bill would have no fiscal effect on agency operations. If an adult care facility or disability services provider is assessed a civil penalty, the fine of \$5,000 or less would be deposited in one of the newly created funds rather than the State General Fund; however, the State Fire Marshal reports that the issuance of civil penalties to these entities is rare.
