
SUBJECT: Fiscal Note for HB 2338 by House Committee on Commerce, Labor and Economic Development

In accordance with KSA 75-3715a, the following fiscal note concerning HB 2338 is respectfully submitted to your committee.

Currently, the Kansas State Board of Cosmetology allows a person to apply for demonstration permit. HB 2338 would change the word 'demonstration' to 'temporary location' or 'temporary guest artist' permit. If the person applying for the permit is not licensed to practice in Kansas, the bill would allow the Board to issue a temporary location permit if a person is licensed in another state or jurisdiction and if the person's license has not been revoked, suspended or conditioned from the practice of such profession. The bill would retain all the conditions currently applied to a demonstration permit and apply them to a temporary location or temporary guest artist permit.

The Board of Cosmetology indicates HB 2338 would not have a fiscal effect on agency operations. The Kansas Association of Counties and the League of Kansas Municipalities state the bill would not have a fiscal effect on cities or counties.
