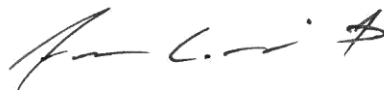
SUBJECT: Fiscal Note for HB 2369 by House Committee on Health and Human Services

In accordance with KSA 75-3715a, the following fiscal note concerning HB 2369 is respectfully submitted to your committee.

HB 2369 would authorize a pharmacist to order and administer any Federal Drug Administration-approved vaccine to patients over seven years of age (or the age the vaccine is approved for, whichever is older). The bill would prohibit a pharmacist from administering any vaccine not able to be administered pursuant to a vaccination protocol, several of which are listed in the bill. The bill would also authorize the Board to adopt regulations listing any additional vaccinations that could not be administered.

The Board of Pharmacy indicates that enactment of HB 2369 would increase staff time to carry out the duties described in the bill. The process of adopting regulations, if necessary, would also take staff time, and the Board would incur costs associated with publication in the *Kansas Register*. The Board states that any fiscal effect on expenditures would be absorbed within existing resources.
