
SUBJECT: Fiscal Note for HB 2563 by House Committee on Health and Human Services

In accordance with KSA 75-3715a, the following fiscal note concerning HB 2563 is respectfully submitted to your committee.

HB 2563 would require day care facilities to keep completed medical record forms on file for each child under ten years of age enrolled for care and each child under 16 years of age who resides in such facility. The Kansas Office of Early Childhood would be required to provide the medical record forms as detailed in the bill. The bill would also make applicable definitions.

According to the Transition Director for the Kansas Office of Early Childhood, enactment of HB 2563 would require form updates, but this would have a negligible fiscal effect on agency operations. Any fiscal effect associated with HB 2563 is not reflected in *The FY 2027 Governor's Budget Report*.
