SUBJECT: Fiscal Note for HB 2640 by House Committee on Elections

In accordance with KSA 75-3715a, the following fiscal note concerning HB 2640 is respectfully submitted to your committee.


HB 2640 would require the Secretary of State to perform periodic comparisons of the state's centralized electronic voter registration database with the United States Department of Homeland Security's systematic alien verification for entitlements database. All data and voter information would be processed in a secure environment consistent with federal and state standards. Any potential noncitizen matches would be sent to the appropriate county election officer. The bill would set forth the process the county election officer would use to verify noncitizen matches provided by the Secretary of State.

The Secretary of State and the county election officer would submit an annual report on the outcomes of the periodic checks to legislative election committees by January 31 of each year. The bill would describe information to be included in the report. The bill's provisions would be severable.

The Secretary of State indicates it would use existing resources to update training materials for local election officials and update educational and promotional materials for the public regarding the provisions of HB 2640. Any fiscal effect associated with HB 2640 is not reflected in *The FY 2027 Governor's Budget Report*.

The Kansas Association of Counties states HB 2640 would increase county staff time to verify potential matches and submit the annual report. The Association is unable to estimate the fiscal effect.
