SUBJECT: Fiscal Note for HB 2650 by Representative Howe


In accordance with KSA 75-3715a, the following fiscal note concerning HB 2650 is respectfully submitted to your committee.

HB 2650 would require that noncompete agreements be reasonable and provide that the agreements would be null and void upon the sale, change in ownership, or control of the business, entity, or partnership. The bill would take effect upon its publication in the statute book.

The Office of Judicial Administration states any fiscal effect resulting from the enactment of the bill could be absorbed within existing resources. The Department of Commerce states the bill's enactment would not have a fiscal effect.

Both the League of Kansas Municipalities and the Kansas Association of Counties state enactment of the bill would not have a fiscal effect on local governments.
