SUBJECT: Fiscal Note for HB 2688 by Representative Bohi, et al.

In accordance with KSA 75-3715a, the following fiscal note concerning HB 2688 is respectfully submitted to your committee.

HB 2688 would provide that a nondisclosure agreement by any party in an action related to childhood sexual abuse or human trafficking would not be judicially enforceable in a dispute involving such claims and would be void. The bill would apply to agreements entered into before July 1, 2026, with certain exceptions.

The Office of Judicial Administration indicates enactment of the bill would have a negligible fiscal effect that could be absorbed within existing resources. Any fiscal effect associated with HB 2688 is not reflected in *The FY 2027 Governor's Budget Report*.
