
SUBJECT: Fiscal Note for HB 2719 by House Committee on Commerce, Labor and Economic Development

In accordance with KSA 75-3715a, the following fiscal note concerning HB 2719 is respectfully submitted to your committee.

HB 2719 would provide that a state agency would not be required to initiate a new rulemaking proceeding under the Rules and Regulations Filing Act, if the agency is proposing only technical amendments to an existing rule or regulation. Upon review and approval by the Department of Administration, an agency may have technical amendments adopted immediately.

The enactment of HB 2719 would have no fiscal effect on the Department of Administration, the Secretary of State, or the Attorney General. The Division of the Budget notes that administrative time would be saved by the Secretary of State, the Attorney General, and the Division of the Budget, as these agencies would no longer have to process technical amendments under the Rules and Regulations Filing Act. However, a fiscal effect from the staff time saved cannot be estimated.
