
SUBJECT: Fiscal Note for SB 104 by Senate Committee on Local Government,
Transparency and Ethics

In accordance with KSA 75-3715a, the following fiscal note concerning SB 104 is respectfully submitted to your committee.

Under current law, every county with a population between 170,000 and 200,000 is required to establish a citizens commission on local government. SB 104 would eliminate this requirement.

The Kansas Association of Counties states there could be a fiscal effect on counties because the bill would eliminate the requirement and any associated cost with a citizens commission on local government. However, a fiscal effect cannot be estimated.
