
**SUBJECT:** Fiscal Note for SB 149 by Senate Committee on Federal and State Affairs

In accordance with KSA 75-3715a, the following fiscal note concerning SB 149 is respectfully submitted to your committee.

SB 149 would amend the Revised Kansas Code for Care of Children by adding a definition of "haircare." The bill would require that a haircare plan be part of the case plan for a child in the custody of the Department for Children and Families (DCF). The bill would require DCF to offer training on culturally competent haircare to foster parents and kinship caregivers.

DCF indicates that enactment of SB 149 would have no fiscal effect on the agency.
