
SUBJECT: Fiscal Note for SB 15 by Senate Committee on Federal and State Affairs

In accordance with KSA 75-3715a, the following fiscal note concerning SB 15 is respectfully submitted to your committee.

SB 15 would allow the Director of Alcoholic Beverage Control of the Department of Revenue to issue liquor licenses to convicted felons when their conviction occurred more than ten years prior to application for a license. This could occur if the Director would determine that sufficient rehabilitation has occurred.

The Department of Revenue indicates if the bill is enacted, the agency would have to revise the background questions on its application, which could be done within existing resources and any cost would be negligible.
