SUBJECT: Fiscal Note for SB 169 by Senate Committee on Utilities


In accordance with KSA 75-3715a, the following fiscal note concerning SB 169 is respectfully submitted to your committee.

SB 169 would amend current law to prohibit mobile home park landlords from limiting a tenant's access to communications and video services.

The Kansas Corporation Commission, Citizens' Utility Ratepayer Board, Office of the Attorney General, and Office of Judicial Administration indicate that the enactment of the bill would not have a fiscal effect on their operations.
