
SUBJECT: Fiscal Note for SB 250 by Senate Committee on Public Health and Welfare

In accordance with KSA 75-3715a, the following fiscal note concerning SB 250 is respectfully submitted to your committee.

SB 250 would create the Right to Try for Individualized Investigative Treatments Act which would allow certain manufacturers to make such treatments available to eligible patients requesting the treatments. The bill would make related definitions, specify requirements for manufacturers and treatments, detail liability exemptions, and include provisions to eliminate conflict with state insurance and health coverage laws.

According to the Kansas State Board of Healing Arts, enactment of SB 250 could lead to some actionable complaints, but the agency anticipates any resulting effect could be managed within existing resources.
