
SUBJECT: Fiscal Note for SB 275 by Senate Committee on Federal and State Affairs

In accordance with KSA 75-3715a, the following fiscal note concerning SB 275 is respectfully submitted to your committee.

SB 275 would change current law relating to curriculum in K-12 schools. The bill would require that any school district that offers any instruction that addresses human growth, human development, or human sexuality would be required to present information regarding the development of the brain, heart, and other vital organs in early human fetal development. The presentation would be of high quality, computer-generated animation or high-definition ultrasound of at least three minutes of duration.

The Department of Education indicates that the enactment of the bill would not have a fiscal effect on state aid to school districts. The Division of the Budget notes that school districts that offer instruction that address human growth, development or sexuality could incur expenses to acquire required animation or ultrasound images. However, a fiscal effect cannot be estimated.
