SUBJECT: Fiscal Note for SB 461 by Senate Committee on Judiciary


In accordance with KSA 75-3715a, the following fiscal note concerning SB 461 is respectfully submitted to your committee.

SB 461 would add a person who is convicted of distribution of a controlled substance causing great bodily harm or death to the definition of "violent offender" under the Kansas Offender Registration Act.

The Kansas Bureau of Investigation indicates enactment of the bill would not have a fiscal effect on the agency.

The Office of Judicial Administration indicates enactment of the bill would have a negligible fiscal effect on the Judicial Branch that could be absorbed within existing resources. Any fiscal effect associated with SB 461 is not reflected in *The FY 2027 Governor's Budget Report*.
