
SUBJECT: Fiscal Note for SB 64 by Senate Committee on Financial Institutions and Insurance

In accordance with KSA 75-3715a, the following fiscal note concerning SB 64 is respectfully submitted to your committee.

SB 64 would extend the timeline for individuals appealing orders or decisions of the KPERS Board of Trustees from 30 days to 60 days. The bill would update current law to reflect recent IRS changes in rules and regulations and other technical amendments to the KPERS statutes.

KPERS indicates that the enactment of the bill would have no fiscal effect. The bill would allow KPERS members a greater window of appealing decisions by the KPERS Board of Trustees.
