SUBJECT: Fiscal Note for SB 97 by Senate Committee on Transportation


In accordance with KSA 75-3715a, the following fiscal note concerning SB 97 is respectfully submitted to your committee.

HB 97 would grant purchasers of nonhighway vehicles the option to obtain a nonhighway certificate of title.

To implement the provisions of the bill, the Department of Revenue would require expenditures totaling \$1,200 from the State General Fund in FY 2026 to make the necessary administrative changes. The Kansas Department of Insurance indicates enactment of the bill would not have a fiscal effect on agency operations. Any fiscal effect associated with SB 97 is not reflected in *The FY 2026 Governor's Budget Report*.

The Kansas Association of Counties states enactment of the bill would have a fiscal effect on counties; however, the Association does not have enough information to estimate a fiscal effect.
