1 AN ACT concerning water; establishing the water program task force to
2 evaluate the state's water program and funding for such program;
3 requiring a report thereon to the legislature and the governor.

5 *Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Kansas:*

6 Section 1. (a) There is hereby established the water program task
7 force. The task force shall consist of:

8 (1) The following ~~29~~ **23** voting members:

9 (A) The chair of the house of representatives committee on water;

10 (B) the chair of the house of representatives committee on agriculture
11 and natural resources;

12 (C) the chair of the house of representatives committee on
13 appropriations;

14 (D) the chair of the senate committee on agriculture and natural
15 resources;

16 (E) the chair of the senate committee on ways and means;

17 (F) the ranking minority member of the house of representatives
18 committee on water;

19 (G) the ranking minority member of the senate agriculture and natural
20 resources committee;

21 ~~(H) one member of the house of representatives appointed by the~~
22 ~~speaker of the house of representatives;~~

23 ~~(H)~~ **(H)** one Kansas resident appointed by the speaker of the house of
24 representatives;

25 ~~(J) one member of the house of representatives appointed by the~~
26 ~~speaker pro tem;~~

27 ~~(K)~~ **(I)** one Kansas resident appointed by the speaker pro tem;

28 ~~(L) one member of the house of representatives appointed by the~~
29 ~~house minority leader;~~

30 ~~(M)~~ **(J)** one Kansas resident appointed by the house minority leader;

31 ~~(N) one member of the senate appointed by the president of the~~
32 ~~senate;~~

33 ~~(O)~~ **(K)** one Kansas resident appointed by the president of the senate;

34 ~~(P) one member of the senate appointed by the vice president of the~~

- 1 ~~(Q)~~(L) one Kansas resident appointed by the vice president of the
2 senate;
- 3 ~~(R)~~ one member of the senate appointed by the senate minority
4 leader;
- 5 ~~(S)~~(M) one Kansas resident appointed by the senate minority leader;
- 6 ~~(T)~~(N) one member appointed by the Kansas farm bureau;
- 7 ~~(U)~~(O) one member appointed by the Kansas groundwater
8 management districts association;
- 9 ~~(V)~~(P) one member of a Kansas agricultural commodity organization
10 appointed by the secretary of agriculture;
- 11 ~~(W)~~(Q) one member appointed by the Kansas livestock association;
- 12 ~~(X)~~(R) one member appointed by Kansas municipal utilities;
- 13 ~~(Y)~~(S) one member appointed by the Kansas association of counties;
- 14 ~~(Z)~~(T) one member appointed by the Kansas rural water district
15 association;
- 16 ~~(AA)~~(U) two members appointed by the Kansas chamber of
17 commerce. One such appointment shall represent a business that is reliant
18 on groundwater, and one such appointment shall represent business that is
19 reliant on surface water; and
- 20 ~~(BB)~~(V) one member appointed by ~~Kansans for conservation the~~
21 **Kansas association of conservation districts**; and
- 22 (2) the following 10 nonvoting ex officio members:
- 23 (A) The secretary of agriculture or the secretary's designee;
- 24 (B) the director of the division of environment of the Kansas
25 department of health and environment or the director's designee;
- 26 (C) the director of the Kansas water office or the director's designee;
- 27 (D) the secretary of the department of revenue or the secretary's
28 designee;
- 29 (E) the director of the Kansas geological survey or the director's
30 designee;
- 31 (F) the chairperson of the state corporation commission or the
32 chairperson's designee;
- 33 (G) the director of the Kansas water institute or the director's
34 designee;
- 35 (H) the secretary of wildlife and parks or the secretary's designee;
- 36 (I) the director of the Kansas biological survey or the director's
37 designee and
- 38 (J) the chief engineer of the Kansas department of agriculture division
39 of water resources or the chief engineer's designee.
- 40 (b) Each member of the task force who is not a member of the
41 legislature shall represent at least one of the following stakeholders:
- 42 (1) A Kansas employer with a vested water right;
- 43 (2) a commercial user of a municipal or industrial water right;

- 1 (3) an agricultural producer;
 - 2 (4) an economic development organization;
 - 3 (5) a water utility;
 - 4 (6) a resident Kansas Indian tribe, Pottawatomie, Kickapoo, Iowa or
5 Sac and Fox;
 - 6 (7) a rural water district;
 - 7 (8) a ~~state~~ **local** conservation district;
 - 8 (9) an organization that focuses on environmental or wildlife
9 protection or conservation;
 - 10 (10) a local water management entity, including, but not limited to, a
11 groundwater management district, water assurance district or ditch district;
 - 12 (11) the Kansas agricultural banking or appraisal industry;
 - 13 (12) a student at a state educational institution engaged in a course of
14 study related to water;
 - 15 (13) a Kansas municipality;
 - 16 (14) a provider of natural resources education;
 - 17 (15) the Kansas agricultural commodity associations;
 - 18 (16) the Kansas water authority or regional advisory committee;
 - 19 (17) the Kansas livestock industry; or
 - 20 (18) the Kansas grain and feed industry.
- 21 (c) (1) Members of the task force shall be residents of Kansas. The
22 task force shall consist of at least ~~two members~~ **one member** from ~~all~~ **each**
23 **of the** five conservation regions of the state. Not more than two members
24 of the task force shall represent the same stakeholder enumerated in
25 subsection (b).
- 26 (2) The speaker of the house of representatives and the president of
27 the senate shall ensure that the requirements of paragraph (1) are met.
- 28 (d) Members of the task force shall be appointed by April 30, 2025.
29 Any vacancy in the membership of the task force shall be filled by
30 appointment in the same manner prescribed by this section for the original
31 appointment.
- 32 (e) The speaker of the house of representatives shall select one
33 member of the task force who is a member of the house of representatives
34 to serve as co-chairperson of the task force. The president of the senate
35 shall select one member of the task force who is a member of the senate to
36 serve as co-chairperson of the task force.
- 37 (f) (1) The task force may meet at any time and at any place within
38 the state upon the call of either co-chairperson.
- 39 (2) A majority of voting members shall constitute a quorum of the
40 task force. All actions of the task force may be taken by a majority of
41 members present when there is a quorum.
- 42 (3) If approved by the legislative coordinating council, members of
43 the task force attending meetings authorized by the task force shall be paid

1 amounts for expenses, mileage and subsistence as provided in K.S.A. 75-
2 3223(e), and amendments thereto.

3 (4) The staff of the office of revisor of statutes, the legislative
4 research department and the division of legislative administrative services
5 shall provide such assistance as may be requested by the task force.

6 (g) The water program task force shall:

7 (1) Evaluate major risks to the quality and quantity of the state's
8 water supply, including any impact on current and future economic growth
9 and population stability;

10 (2) steps that the state must take to define and achieve an ongoing,
11 multigenerational promise of water for Kansans; and

12 (3) evaluate current funding for water in the state and determine
13 whether such funding is sufficient to address the water issues included in
14 the state water plan, including the state's current and future water
15 infrastructure needs.

16 (h) The task force shall prepare and submit a report to the legislature
17 and the governor on or before January 31, 2026. Such report shall include
18 recommendations on:

19 (1) The water program's long-term structure to address the state's
20 current and future water needs, including, but not limited to:

21 (A) The roles and responsibilities of the state, municipalities and
22 regional entities;

23 (B) how the program's investments and successes should be
24 evaluated, including gathering any stakeholder input; and

25 (C) criteria to determine program investments, including geographic
26 diversity of such investments; and

27 (2) funding for the water program, including, but not limited to:

28 (A) New dedicated moneys or investments for the state water plan
29 fund;

30 (B) changes to any existing fees or moneys dedicated to the state
31 water plan fund; and

32 (C) any additional funding sources or tools necessary to ensure that
33 the financial resources are adequate to address the state's water issues.

34 (i) This section shall expire on July 1, 2027.

35 Sec. 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its
36 publication in the Kansas register.
