1 AN ACT concerning legal public holidays; declaring the even-numbered
2 year general election day as a legal public holiday; amending K.S.A.
3 35-107 and repealing the existing section.

5 *Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Kansas:*

6 Section 1. K.S.A. 35-107 is hereby amended to read as follows: 35-
7 107. (a) ~~On and after January 1, 2006,~~ The following days are declared to
8 be legal public holidays and are to be observed as such:

9 New Year's Day, January 1;

10 Martin Luther King, Jr. Day, the third Monday in January;

11 President's Day, the third Monday in February;

12 Memorial Day, the last Monday in May;

13 Independence Day, July 4;

14 Labor Day, the first Monday in September;

15 Columbus Day, the second Monday in October;

16 Veterans' Day, the eleventh day in November;

17 *Election Day, the Tuesday following the first Monday in even-*
18 *numbered years;*

19 Thanksgiving Day, the fourth Thursday in November;

20 Christmas Day, December 25.

21 (b) Any reference in the laws of this state concerning observance of
22 legal holidays shall ~~on and after January 1, 2006,~~ be considered as a
23 reference to the day or days prescribed in subsection (a) for the observance
24 of such legal holiday or holidays.

25 Sec. 2. K.S.A. 35-107 is hereby repealed.

26 Sec. 3. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its
27 publication in the statute book.
