AN ACT concerning legal public holidays; declaring the even-numbered

2 year general election day as a legal public holiday; amending K.S.A. 3 35-107 and repealing the existing section. 4 5 Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Kansas: Section 1. K.S.A. 35-107 is hereby amended to read as follows: 35-6 107. (a) On and after January 1, 2006, The following days are declared to 7 be legal public holidays and are to be observed as such: 8 9 New Year's Day, January 1; Martin Luther King, Jr. Day, the third Monday in January; 10 President's Day, the third Monday in February; 11 Memorial Day, the last Monday in May; 12 Independence Day, July 4; 13 Labor Day, the first Monday in September; 14 Columbus Day, the second Monday in October; 15 16 Veterans' Day, the eleventh day in November; 17 Election Day, the Tuesday following the first Monday in even-18 numbered vears; 19 Thanksgiving Day, the fourth Thursday in November;

21 (b) Any reference in the laws of this state concerning observance of 22 legal holidays shall-on and after January 1, 2006, be considered as a 23 reference to the day or days prescribed in subsection (a) for the observance 24

of such legal holiday or holidays.

Christmas Day, December 25.

Sec. 2. K.S.A. 35-107 is hereby repealed.

26 Sec. 3. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its 27 publication in the statute book.
