1 AN ACT concerning public assistance; relating to medical assistance; 2 requiring approval by an act of the legislature prior to any state agency 3 seeking or implementing a medicaid state plan, state plan amendment, 4 state demonstration or waiver under section 1115 or 1915 of the federal 5 social security act that expands coverage or increases cost to the state or changes funding structures and services for persons with 6 7 intellectual disabilities; delegating approval of such plans and changes to the legislative coordinating council when the legislature 8 9 is not in session

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11 Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Kansas:

12 Section 1. (a) On and after July 1, 2025, no state agency shall seek or 13 implement:

(1) (A) A medicaid state plan, state plan amendment, state demonstration or waiver pursuant to section 1115 or 1915 of the federal social security act that would expand coverage to any additional individuals or class of individuals or would increase any cost to the state unless the legislature expressly consents to, and approves of, such medicaid state plan, state plan amendment, state demonstration or waiver by an act of the legislature.

(B) The provisions of this paragraph shall not affect any state plan
 amendment or waiver program already being implemented prior to July 1,
 2025; or

(2) any changes to funding structures, day services or targeted
 case management services for persons with intellectual or
 developmental disabilities unless the legislature expressly consents to
 and approves of such changes by an act of the legislature.

(b) (1) When the legislature is not in session, a state agency may
request approval from the legislative coordinating council to authorize
a medicaid state plan, state plan amendment, state demonstration or
waiver or changes to funding structures, day services or targeted case
management services for persons with intellectual or developmental
disabilities.

34 (2) Pursuant to K.S.A. 46-1202, and amendments thereto, the 35 legislative coordinating council may approve or refuse an agency's

## request or designate a standing committee or special committee to 1

- review an agency's request and make recommendations to the 2
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- legislative coordinating council based on the committee's review.(c) For purposes of this section, "state agency" means the same as 4 defined in K.S.A. 75-3701, and amendments thereto. 5
- Sec. 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its 6 publication in the statute book. 7
