AN ACT concerning the practice of cosmetology; relating to
 demonstration permits; authorizing the Kansas state board of
 cosmetology to issue temporary location permits and temporary guest
 body artist permits; establishing criteria to issue such permits;
 amending K.S.A. 2024 Supp. 65-1958 and repealing the existing
 section.

8 Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Kansas:

9 Section 1. K.S.A. 2024 Supp. 65-1958 is hereby amended to read as 10 follows: 65-1958. (a) Any person may apply to the Kansas state board of 11 cosmetology for a demonstration *temporary location or temporary guest* 12 *artist* permit. Any such application shall be on a form and in a manner 13 approved by the board and accompanied by the fee established under 14 K.S.A. 65-1950, and amendments thereto.

(b) (1) The board may grant a temporary location permit to a person
authorized under K.S.A. 65-1940 through 65-1954, and amendments
thereto. If a person who applies for a temporary location permit is not
licensed in this state, the board may grant a temporary location permit if:

20 (A) Such person is licensed to practice such profession regulated 21 under K.S.A. 65-1940 through 65-1954, and amendments thereto, in 22 another state or jurisdiction; and

23 (B) such license has not been revoked, suspended or conditioned from
24 the practice of such profession.

25 (2) The board may grant a demonstration temporary guest artist 26 permit to a person to provide services authorized under K.S.A. 65-1940 through 65-1954, and amendments thereto, at a state or national 27 28 convention, an establishment licensed by the Kansas state board of 29 cosmetology or any other event location approved by the board. If a person 30 who applies for a demonstration permit to provide such services is not 31 licensed in this state, the board may grant a demonstration temporary 32 guest artist permit if:

(A) Such person is licensed to practice such profession regulated
 under K.S.A. 65-1940 through 65-1954, and amendments thereto, in
 another state or jurisdiction; and

1 (B) such license has not been revoked, suspended or conditioned 2 from the practice of such profession.

(2)(3) If an application for a demonstration temporary location or 3 temporary guest artist permit is submitted by a citizen of a foreign country 4 who has not been issued a social security number-and who has not nor 5 been licensed by any other state, the board shall not require the applicant 6 7 to submit a social security number and shall instead accept a valid visa or 8 passport identification number.

(3) (4) Any-demonstration temporary location or temporary guest 9 artist permit issued under this section shall expire not later than 14 days 10 after issuance-of by the board. 11

12 (c) The board shall adopt rules and regulations as necessary to implement and administer this section. Such rules and regulations shall be 13 adopted on or before December 31, 2023. 14

(d) This section shall be a part of and supplemental to K.S.A. 65-15 16 1940 through 65-1954, and amendments thereto.
