A PROPOSITION to amend section 6 of article 6 of the constitution of
 the state of Kansas; limiting the use of public funds appropriated for
 elementary or secondary educational purposes for secular public
 schools and prohibiting public funds from being used for private
 nonpublic schools.

WHEREAS, This proposition to amend the Constitution of the State of Kansas shall be known and may be cited as the Protect

8 State of Kansas shall be known and may
9 Public Schools Amendment.

10 Now, therefore:

Be it resolved by the Legislature of the State of Kansas, two-thirds of the
members elected (or appointed) and qualified to the House of
Representatives and two-thirds of the members elected (or appointed)
and qualified to the Senate concurring therein:

15 Section 1. The following proposition to amend the constitution 16 of the state of Kansas shall be submitted to the qualified electors of the 17 state for their approval or rejection: Section 6 of article 6 of the 18 constitution of the state of Kansas is hereby amended to read as follows:

"§ 6. Finance. (a) The legislature may levy a permanent tax
for the use and benefit of state institutions of higher education and
apportion among and appropriate the same to the several
institutions, which levy, apportionment and appropriation shall
continue until changed by statute. Further appropriation and other
provision for finance of institutions of higher education may be
made by the legislature.

(b) The legislature shall make suitable provision for finance of
the educational interests of the state. No tuition shall be charged for
attendance at any public school to pupils required by law to attend
such school, except such fees or supplemental charges as may be
authorized by law. The legislature may authorize the state board of
regents to establish tuition, fees and charges at institutions under its
supervision.

33 (c) No religious sect or sects shall control any part of the 34 public educational funds Public moneys appropriated for

1 appropriated only for secular public schools. No public moneys 2 shall be appropriated or paid nor any public credit be utilized by the legislature or any other political subdivision of the state, 3 directly or indirectly, to aid or maintain any private nonpublic 4 school that provides elementary or secondary education." 5 6 Sec. 2. The following statement shall be printed on the ballot with 7 the amendment as a whole: 8 "Explanatory statement. The Protect Public Schools Amendment would limit the use of K-12 educational public 9 funds for secular public schools and prohibit public funds 10 from being used for private nonpublic schools. 11 "A vote for the Protect Public Schools Amendment would 12 amend the constitution of the state of Kansas to explicitly 13 limit the use of K-12 educational public funds for secular 14 public schools and prohibit public funds from being used for 15 private nonpublic schools. 16 17 "A vote against the Protect Public Schools Amendment would 18 not amend the constitution of the state of Kansas." 19 This resolution, if approved by two-thirds of the members Sec. 3. elected (or appointed) and gualified to the House of Representatives and 20 two-thirds of the members elected (or appointed) and qualified to the 21 Senate, shall be entered on the journals, together with the yeas and nays. 22 The secretary of state shall cause this resolution to be published as 23 provided by law and shall cause the proposed amendment to be submitted 24 to the electors of the state at the general election in November in the year 25 2026, unless a special election is called at a sooner date by concurrent 26 resolution of the legislature, in which case the proposed amendment shall 27 be submitted to the electors of the state at the special election. 28
