AN ACT concerning children and minors; relating to child labor; 1 2 increasing the penalty for unlawful employment of any person or child; 3 amending K.S.A. 38-612 and repealing the existing section. 4 5 Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Kansas: Section 1. K.S.A. 38-612 is hereby amended to read as follows: 38-6 7 612. That (a) Any person, firm or corporation employing any person or child in violation of any provision of this act, or permitting or conniving at 8 9 such violation, shall be deemed guilty of a misdemeanor, and upon-10 conviction thereof shall be fined in a sum not less than twenty-five dollars nor more than one hundred dollars, or by imprisonment in the county jail 11 12 for a period of not less than thirty days nor more than ninety days: 13 (1) Class A person misdemeanor, except as provided in subsections 14 (a)(2) and (a)(3); 15 (2) severity level 7, person felony upon a second conviction; and 16 (3) severity level 5, person felony upon a third or subsequent 17 conviction. 18 (b) In addition to any other criminal penalties provided by law, any 19 person convicted of a violation of this section for a second time shall pay a 20 fine in an amount of \$25,000 and any person convicted of a violation of 21 this section for a third or subsequent time shall pay a fine in an amount of 22 \$50,000. 23 Sec. 2. K.S.A. 38-612 is hereby repealed.
