1	A CONCURRENT RESOLUTION encouraging the Governor-Kelly to
2	fully cooperate with the policies of the Trump administration in
3	enforcing federal immigration laws.

5	WHEREAS, The state of Kansas is committed to upholding the rule of
6	law and ensuring the safety and security of its citizens; and
7	WHEREAS, Illegal immigration leads to severe repercussions for our
8	entire state, including threats to public safety and public health via human
9	trafficking, the deadly fentanyl crisis and strains on public resources; and
10	WHEREAS, The Trump administration has expressed a commitment to
11	enforce immigration laws via a historic operation led by his border czar,
12	including deportation; and
13	WHEREAS, The <i>main</i> priority of this massive operation-will include
14	<i>is</i> the deportation of illegal immigrants who have committed crimes; and
15	WHEREAS, This effort is-increasingly becoming a bipartisan effort, as
16	evidenced by the bipartisan support of the Laken Riley Act, including by
17	our entire congressional delegation; and
18	WHEREAS, Collaboration between state and federal authorities is
19	essential for effective and efficient enforcement and to address the myriad
20	challenges associated with illegal immigration; and
21	WHEREAS, Many states are at the forefront of the effort to secure-our
22	border the United States borders and work with the Trump
23	administration to do so, and Kansas needs to join this effort; and
24	WHEREAS, Some states and local jurisdictions have indicated that
25	they will resist the Trump administration's efforts to secure the border and
26	deport illegal immigrants; and
27	WHEREAS, Kansas, thus, needs to make it clear that we stand united
28	in support of the Trump administration's efforts to secure our border the
29	United States borders, stop illegal immigration and protect our
30	communities: Now, therefore,
31	Be it resolved by the Senate of the State of Kansas, the House of
32	Representatives concurring therein: That the Legislature strongly urges
33	the Governor-Laura Kelly to fully cooperate with the Trump
34	administration in enforcing immigration laws in the state of Kansas,
35	including the deportation of illegal immigrants; and
36	Be it further resolved: That the Legislature encourages the Governor

- 1 Kelly to use her lawful authority to help secure the-border United States
- 2 borders, including offering assistance through the Kansas National
- 3 Guard, as stated in resolutions adopted by the Legislature in 2024; and

Be it further resolved: That the Legislature will continue to support efforts aimed at securing-our *the United States* borders and reducing illegal immigration while fostering a legal immigration system that meets the needs of the state and our country; and

8 *Be it further resolved:* That the Secretary of State shall send an 9 enrolled copy of this resolution to *the* Governor-Laura Kelly, members of 10 the Kansas congressional delegation, President Donald J. Trump and 11 relevant federal entities to promote awareness and collaboration on this 12 vital issue.
