SUPPLEMENTAL NOTE ON HOUSE BILL NO. 2261

As Recommended by House Committee on <u>Transportation</u>

Brief*

HB 2261 would add majors of the Kansas Highway Patrol (KHP) as being in unclassified service under the Kansas Civil Service Act.

The bill also would provide permanent status for a person returning to a classified KHP position at the end of a term in an unclassified KHP position. Under continuing law, the rank to which the officer would return would not be lower than the rank the person held when appointed to an unclassified position: superintendent, assistant superintendent, or major.

Background

The bill was introduced by the House Committee on Transportation at the request of a representative of the KHP.

House Committee on Transportation

In the House Committee hearing, the KHP Executive Officer provided **proponent** testimony. He stated current statutory language is unclear as to whether the position of major is classified or unclassified, which has resulted in litigation and uncertainty, and that all six current majors voluntarily accepted unclassified status upon appointment.
