2023 Kansas Statutes

- **25-804.** Selection of presidential electors; certification of names to secretary of state. (a) Each political party that is a recognized political party in accordance with K.S.A. 25-302a, and amendments thereto, shall adopt procedures to select presidential electors and select presidential electors in accordance with such procedures.
- (b) (1) The names of the presidential electors for a presidential candidate of a political party with a state organization shall be certified to the secretary of state by the chairperson of the state political party.
- (2) The names of presidential electors for presidential candidates of a political party that does not have a state organization shall be certified to the secretary of state by the chairperson of the national political party.
- (3) The names of presidential electors for independent presidential candidates shall be selected and certified to the secretary of state by the candidate.
- (c) All names of presidential electors shall be certified to the secretary of state on or before September 1 of the year in which there is a presidential election. **History:** L. 1981, ch. 165, § 10; L. 2023, ch. 24, § 4; July 1.
