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## **Deferred Maintenance**


- \* State universities are stewards for:
  - 818 state-owned buildings which encompass 30 million square feet and represent two-thirds of the state's buildings
  - At least 75% of the buildings are 30 years or older
  - 26.214 acres of land
  - · Replacement value of \$7.3 billion
- ★ According to our 2010 deferred maintenance report, it is estimated to be over \$900 million
- ★ Funds needed for annual maintenance is estimated to be approximately \$90 million


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



### **Deferred Maintenance**


- ★ Educational building fund was authorized in 1918 and has been a one mill statewide levy since 1955.
- ★ Since 1997, one half of the levy has been used to pay off the Crumbling Classroom bonds which will be paid off in FY 12.
- ★ In FY 13, the educational building fund will have \$30+ million for use by universities.
- ★ Dedicated annual state funds of \$60-70 million coupled with funds from university budgets would make significant progress on deferred maintenance.























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## Financial Aid

- \* In 2009-2010
  - Kansas was among 15 states who spent less than 5% of higher education funding on state financial aid
  - National Average = 11%
- ★ Per undergraduate FTE, the Kansas expenditure on financial aid was \$130
  - National Average = \$627
  - College Board
